MEMBERSHIP TYPES.

ORDINARY MEMBER

Every candidate for admission as an Ordinary Member shall be an adult of good repute and shall have signed an application form prescribed by the committee certifying that the candidate is over the age of sixteen years and is prepared to be bound by the Memorandum and Articles of Association. On acceptance to the club an ordinary member shall be entitled to the full privileges of membership and shall be affiliated with Q.G.F.A and G.F.A.A.

ADDITIONAL ORDINARY MEMBER

An Additional Ordinary Member shall be entitled to the same privileges as an Ordinary Member with the exception that an Additional Ordinary Member will not receive Club Newsletters etc. Additional Ordinary Membership is mainly for family members in addition to the main member where all correspondence goes to the same address.

JUNIOR MEMBER

Any person who is under the age of sixteen years at the beginning of the Club's financial year (1st July) who is elected to membership of the Club in accordance with the rules applicable to Ordinary Members shall be a Junior Member during that year and succeeding years until attaining the age of sixteen years, at which time Ordinary Membership shall be granted automatically. A Junior Member shall be entitled to all the privileges of Ordinary Membership, save that a Junior Member shall not be eligible for office within the Club nor shall be entitled to vote at any meeting of the Club.

AFFILIATE MEMBER

Every candidate for admission as an Affiliate Member shall be an adult of good repute and shall have signed an application form prescribed by the committee certifying that he/she is over the age of sixteen years and is prepared to be bound by the Memorandum and Articles of Association. An Affiliate Member shall be entitled to all the privileges of an Ordinary Member except that Affiliate Members are not affiliated with Q.G.F.A. or G.F.A.A. and as such may not be awarded points in Club competitions or be eligible for the award of Club, State. National or International records solely by virtue of their being Affiliate Members of the Club. An affiliate Member shall pay a reduced membership fee which shall be fixed by the Committee from time to time at its discretion. An Affiliate Member shall not have voting rights.

PERPETUAL MEMBER

Every candidate for admission as a Perputual Member shall be an adult of good repute and shall have signed an application form prescribed by the Committee certifying that he/she is over the age of sixteen years and is prepared to be bound by the Memorandum and Articles of Association. A Perputual Member shall be entitled to the same privileges as an Ordinary Member. A Perputual Member shall pay a once only Membership fee which will be fixed by the Committee at its discretion.
